Evaluation

- ✓ Subject Leader monitoring from year R-6, focusing on standards and achievements in dance through enhanced learning and teaching
- ✓ Collaborative planning including preparation of resources, technical vocabulary focus, clear use of learning objectives and success criteria
- ✓ Collaborative focussed assessment and evaluation of impact to inform next steps
- ✓ Improved use and understanding of technical vocabulary by pupils
- ✓ Focused peer assessments by pupils and teachers to inform judgements and next steps
- ✓ Use of display Working Wall to support and celebrate learning and teaching
- ✓ All children (year R-6) want to perform, no gender differences; performances by Secondary Schools motivated and enhanced pupils' experiences of quality dance

Ways Forward

- Broaden and develop bank of warm-up activities and ideas for dance
- Continue to develop resources to support dance for colleagues eg music, visual stimulus
- Develop use of assessment document to roll-out to all classes and year groups during next cycle of dance teaching
- Further develop use of digital recording and peer assessments
- > Focus on further ideas and monitoring of differentiation to support achievement in dance for all
- > Re-site whiteboard in the hall to display during lessons whilst being able to use projector and screen simultaneously
- Consider future use of digital technology to support learning and teaching in PE
