2.	Approve the minutes of the last meeting – Thursday 26 th September 2019
	These were approved as an accurate record.
3.	Co-Chairs' Report
	Jen and Amy reported the following:
	 Amy thanked everyone for coming, and for all the work put into the Mayors Procession in which we came 1st, and that the pay-out for this is still to come. A massive thank you to the Cuckfield Bonfire Team, as due to the weather there was only a £400 profit made on the stall, this is now to be reviewed for next year. Thank you to the class reps for all the communications sent, and to please now push the Christmas Fair Signup. Voluntary Contributions Team – sent out a fabulous video outlining what our money goes towards paying for the educational events in school – great job!
4.	Treasurer's Report
	Ailsa reported that we have made £600 profit from the children's Christmas cards this year, and that there is £4000 that has been allocated towards long term projects already. The Co-Op money that was raised is still to come, however it does still leave the PTA a healthy cash balance.
5.	Head Teacher's Report
	Ann reported that the forest schools experience has already started for this term, and that there is also a musical workshop starting this month too.
6.	Funding Requests
	 Reception Classes presented a list of requests totalling approximately £3000, this included a lot of outdoor equipment. Yrs. 3/4/5 need more reading and maths materials for termly assessments which is approximately £350 – there is already £1600 allocated to books already and could potentially come under the Power of Reading fund. Yr. 6 - £350 same requested for Dyslexia book requests

Grounds Days have been set to the following: 25th/26th Jan – 29th /1st Feb/Mar – 25th/26th Apr – 13th/14th Jun.
	 The £2400 of Co-Op money is going towards the outside classroom.
	A film night has been suggested for 21 st /22 nd January instead of a Disco.
